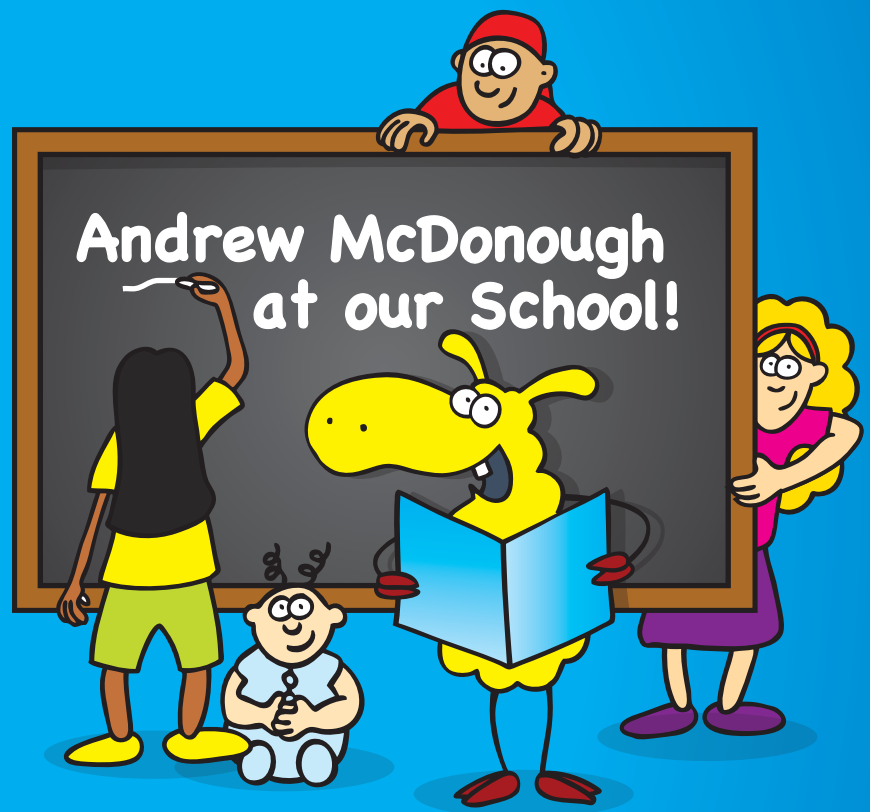


THE ANDREW MCDONOUGH SCHOOL VISIT 'STORY TELLING EXTRAVAGANZA'

Details for a Full Day Visit (consider a 3-5 day visit.)

Assembly and Chapel: Andrew is happy to share between 5 -15 minutes at assembly or chapel.

Sessions: It works best if Andrew is based in one spot and the kids come to him.

What Andrew needs: A data projector or nifty smartboard. A whiteboard or two can also be handy. A glass of water and maybe a coffee. If possible, a microphone.

Time: 40-55 minute sessions work best. Up to five sessions a day.

Group Size: one to two classes per session works well. The smaller the group the more interaction. If there are over 50 kids per session, make the coffee strong.

Content: Andrew tells between 2-5 stories, shares how he creates a book showing the children original drawings, early drafts, printer proofs and line art images. He often draws for the kids and sometimes the kids draw as well. Sessions may include a demonstration of computer graphic design of a book page. There is plenty of interaction.

What about the older kids? Definitely include a session for the grade 6 and 7s. They will enjoy it.
